1. Start to fill in Ship's Log, Cruising Log, and Radio Log..... \_\_\_\_\_
2. Perform Engine check..... \_\_\_\_\_
3. Check for proper number of lifejackets for each person on board ..... \_\_\_\_\_
4. Check fire extinguishers..... \_\_\_\_\_
5. Check distress flares ..... \_\_\_\_\_
6. Check first aid kit(s)..... \_\_\_\_\_
7. Check Ship's bell..... \_\_\_\_\_
8. Check Ship's signaling horn..... \_\_\_\_\_
9. Check Navigation Lights for operation ..... \_\_\_\_\_
10. Turn lower helm station GPS/Sounder **ON** ..... \_\_\_\_\_
11. Turn VHF radio(s) **ON**, perform radio check ..... \_\_\_\_\_
12. Confirm GPS Position is shown on VHF Radios ..... \_\_\_\_\_
13. Place life ring and heaving line on bow and stern..... \_\_\_\_\_
14. Place Life Sling on stern ..... \_\_\_\_\_
15. Place boat hook on the bow and stern ..... \_\_\_\_\_
16. Check man overboard dinghy, make sure oars are on board ..... \_\_\_\_\_
17. Check for proper anchor gear..... \_\_\_\_\_
18. Check for working flashlight..... \_\_\_\_\_
19. Check to make sure proper charts are on board for destination ..... \_\_\_\_\_
20. Make sure there is a copy of COLREG-72 on board..... \_\_\_\_\_
21. Make sure large lock lines are on board ..... \_\_\_\_\_
22. Hoist the US Ensign, USCG AUX pennant, USCG AUX OP pennant, Patrol Signs..... \_\_\_\_\_
23. Make sure extra line and fenders are on board ..... \_\_\_\_\_
24. Inform Coxswain that the Facility is prepared to get underway..... \_\_\_\_\_
